Qualifying households must present proof of identification, income, residence and a copy of bill to apply for the program. The discount is <b>not</b> applicable to commercial or industrial customers.				
* <b>The Senior Citizen Discount and Low Income Discount are mutually exclusive.</b> An account holder may only receive one such discount at any period. If at the time of application for the discount an account holder is eligible and applies for both discounts, then only the Senior Citizen Discount shall be applied to charges after the date of application, but not the Low Income Discount."
